

GLENWAY COUNTRY CLUB RECIPROCAL PROGRAM 2009

After a successful year in 2008, we are pleased to announce to the Full, Transitional Associate, and Weekday members of Glenway Country Club the return of the reciprocal play program. Through our efforts over the winter months, we were able to develop this playing program with a few local golf clubs. Once again we have made arrangements with Carrying Place Golf & Country Club, Sleepy Hollow Golf Club, & The Briars Golf Club. This program has been developed and implemented with the support of Glenway Country Club, and the Golf Committees of all our clubs. All of the clubs we have chosen are within a one hour drive from Glenway.

RECIPROCAL PROGRAM RULES:

1. Each club has provided tee times over the course of the playing season.
2. Registration must be in foursomes, and all four players must be golf members of the respective club.
3. There will be no cost to participate in the program.
4. Players wishing to take power carts can purchase them at the visiting golf club.
5. Visiting players will have full clubhouse privileges and likewise must abide by all member rules at the host club.
6. Each club professional will advise the other at the beginning of the week as to the details of the visiting foursome for that week.
7. Cancellations must be made at least 10 days in advance.
8. Administration of the program will not be the responsibility of the pro shop staff. The registration process will take place on the following basis:
 - a. Any foursomes proposing to take advantage of the program should complete the attached registration form and forward it to the pro shop, on or before Monday, June 1, 2009.
 - b. A lottery will be conducted (using the preferred date priorities indicated on the registration forms) and foursomes will be thereby, allocated to the designated dates. The "Member Contact", as indicated on the registration form, will be notified as to the lottery results.
 - c. Any dates remaining after the lottery will be filled on a first come first serve basis. A summary of the available dates will be located in the pro shop.
9. The overall program will be administered by the Head Golf Professional. Any issues relating to the program should be directed to David Ninno. Assuming that Glenway Country Club sends a foursome to each of the clubs for each date, NO increase in play at Glenway will result. We look forward to our membership taking full advantage of this wonderful opportunity to play some other great golf clubs.
