When Glenway Country Club opened its doors in 1987 it brought with it explosive changes to the community and to Newmarket. The club now serves the recreation needs of over 3,500 members. The driving force behind this magnificent Club, is its Golf Course with the creative design input from Robinson & Carrick. The golf course offers unique concepts in land use, stressing conservation and the strategic placement of ponds, bunkers and berms which creates a fair test for every Golfer. The challenging Par 70 course is approximately 6,200 yards and has a course rating of 70. The course record, which was 67, was broken during the 1992 Ontario Open by Robert Meyer who shot an impressive 63! The Canadian Tour Golfers gained respect for the course as one of the most exciting stops on their tour.
